Dates: Memorial Day Weekend, Friday, Saturday, & Sunday May 27 – May 29, 2011

Entry Fees: \$498 per team (\$249 per person)

Registration: Closes on May 25, 2011 or when the field is full. After that date registrations will be taken on a space available basis only. The Kitsap Golf Group reserves the right to modify field limits to achieve a total field size of 48 teams.

Divisions: Teams will compete in six divisions based on age and gender. There will be six flights; Men's & Women's Open (under 50), Senior (50-64) & Super Senior (65+).

Handicap Requirements: Each participant must be an amateur with proof of a current USGA or RCGA Handicap Index/Factor. There is no minimum handicap. The maximum daily handicap men will play with is 36.4 and women 40.4, regardless of index.

Tee Times: Friday at 1:30p, Saturday & Sunday at 8:00a. Tournament play will begin daily with a shotgun start.

Check-in: May 27th at 11:00a. Course assignments will be posted on the website kamgc.com on or before May 23, 2011.

What is included: Each player is guaranteed three rounds of golf including golf cart (2 participants per cart), range balls and welcome packet with items valued at up to \$100, tickets to the libation tent at each course, an opportunity to win a golf vacation from Alaska Airlines Vacations to beautiful Los Cabos, Mexico.

Rules: USGA Rules of Golf will govern play. All disputes regarding any aspect of tournament play will be reviewed by the Rules Committee. All committee rulings are final. Rules can be viewed on the United States Golf Association web site at USGA.org. A rules official will be available at each course to answer any questions and to make any required official rulings. Any questions need to be addressed to the rules official prior to signing your daily score card.

Lodgings: Silverdale Beach Hotel – the “Official Host Site” – has prepared special rates for all KAM tournament participants. If you do not wish to stay at the Silverdale you can Contact the Kitsap Peninsula Visitor & Convention Bureau at visitkitsap.com for additional lodging options.

Scoring: All teams will receive their scorecards at the course they are playing that day. Teams must exchange their scorecards with a participant from the other team in the group. No team shall keep their own scorecard. Players should record gross (actual) scores only. Net scores will be calculated by the Scoring Committee.

At the conclusion of each round, all teams must turn in their signed and attested scorecards (cards must be signed by a player on the team and by the scorer/marker from the other team) to the

designated scoring area. Any team who leaves the course without signing or turning in their scorecard will be disqualified. Any team who does not turn in their scorecard to the designated scoring area immediately after play on their 18th hole MAY be subject to disqualification.

Official Rulings: Any player seeking a ruling must contact the on-course Rules Official and have a ruling declared before signing the scorecard. If you have doubt as to how to proceed and do not want to wait for a Rules Official, the following action must be taken:

- Announce to someone on the other team that you are going to play two balls.
- Announce to someone on the other team which ball you prefer to score.
- Play out the hole with both balls, recording both scores.
- Prior to signing your scorecard, report the facts to the Rules Official at your respective course (unless you score the same with both balls). The Rules Official will assist in determining the correct score to mark on your scorecard. If you fail to do so, the penalty is two strokes except when otherwise provided.

Daily Incentive Contests:

- Closest-to-the-Pin prizes will be awarded for each individual flight each day. (Holes will be designated by each course).
- Daily payouts will be available each day at each course.
- Hole-In-One – All Tournament Rounds – Participants will be recognized and awarded a prize.
- Results will be posted nightly at evening “19th hole” functions and on the official tournament website. Scores will not be posted at individual golf courses.

Cancellation Policy: Full refunds less a \$25 processing fee will be provided for cancellations received at the tournament office at P.O. Box 1645, Mercer Island, WA 98040, by 6:00 p.m., P.S.T., Friday, April 15, 2011. Cancellations received between May 1 and May 15, 2011 will be refunded a total of \$150 less the processing fee. No refunds, regardless of circumstance, will be provided after May 15, 2011. All cancellations and refund requests must be submitted in writing to the tournament office. Please allow four weeks for the processing of refund requests.

Practice Rounds: Practice rounds are not included in your entry fee but discount tee times may be available through each course. Rates for practice rounds are determined by each facility and availability is not guaranteed.
